IT'S GOLDIE ROCKS broke sharp, cleared to the inside, set all the pace, larger lead a furlong out, held late. LOVE PRODUCTION forwardly placed along the inside, continued to race within striking distance into the straight, fell back a bit off the winner with a furlong to run, roused, coming late. ASPEN TRIAL settled off the pace, three wide into the lane, staged a mild rally late. LUCKY SPANX evenly paced while saving ground, moved out for the drive, modest close. LITTLE KING off the pace, came four wide into the stretch, lacked a serious kick. TOUGH MADAME void of speed, also came four wide into the lane, improved position a bit by passing tiring foes. CELLIST HANNA settled off the pace, had little to offer for the drive. A LITTLE LIGHT closest to the winner for six furlongs, gave way in the drive. KINGS SALTWORKS last to leave, trailed throughout in showing little.
