Footnotes

DANCING DUDETE trailed out of the chute, continued to be outrun through the turn while saving ground, roused, finished fast, moved out late, kicked down the leader to be in time. LADY BLUE BELLE away in good order from the outside, dueled off the rail, shook well clear before a half, continued to hold a sizeable advantage past the furlong marker, could not contain the winner, remained well clear for the place. BETTY LOU did not break with the field, steadily advanced up the inside, moved off the inside when closest to the runner up when straightened for home, could do little more with that foe, no match for the winner. BEFORE HER TIME went one paced throughout while racing in the three path. SUGARTOWN LADY broke alertly, showed the way out of the chute, dueled inside the runner up early, faded while in the two path out of the turn. SMOOTH SEA in a bit tight at the start, made little impact. TIGER EYED was finished early. HONKY TONKS HEAT staged a steady retreat.
