### Footnotes

WILBY'S RAY behind the first flight for three furlongs toward the inside, lacked clear room a furlong out, moved out, split foes with a sixteenth remaining, edged clear. SEATTLE IMP last away, trailed for three furlongs, moved to the outside for the drive, roused, slowly gaining. BRILLIANT CUT asked early along the inside, narrowly set the pace until less than a furlong remained, weakened, caught late for the place. WESTERN PINE broke alertly, pressured the pace while between foes into the turn, lacked a late punch. AMERICANUS vied up front four wide into the turn, faltered in the drive. BONZAWAY pressured the issue three wide and between foes into the turn, gave way.
