PRINCE ALLIANCE broke alertly, soon got clear, rated while maintaining a daylight advantage through the turn, kept to task midstretch. CY'S HOPE off the pace and the inside, four wide out of the turn, made a late run to be up for the place, no threat to the winner. TRUE PRIDE behind the pace, saved ground into the stretch, could do little with the winner late, drifted out despite a right handed stick, caught for the place. WILDCAT ROAD forwardly placed while off the inside, came in slightly, brushed final strides, not enough for the show. GARRETT'S MONEYBAG last to leave, trailed well back, swung to the outside for the drive, improved position. CAJUN SPICE fell back after breaking in good order, never a serious threat. HOT ACE chased the winner, was tiring when bothered and brushed late, continued to fade. MR. ROSEBUD four wide when well off the pace late turn, failed to rally. JOHN HALO was finished early.
