Footnotes

MARGOS WALKER outrun in the early going, began a steady gain late backstretch, five wide through the second turn, challenged on the outside entering the stretch, vied past the furlong marker then edged away late under steady handling. HONOUR ROCKET moved up to be four wide into the first turn, stalked then vied backstretch, raced between foes and inside the winner turning for home, equal terms with that rival a furlong out, second best. WAKKIANO vied up front between rivals backstretch, closest to the inside turning for home, could not match the top two the final furlong, well clear of the others. ALLIE'S TABOO devoid of early foot in trailing, continued to see them all second turn, swung out to be five wide late in the final bend, staged a mild rally down the middle of the strip. SOCKET narrowly showed the way into the first turn, continued to contest the pace while closest to the inside the middle half, weakened. DUSTY TUNNEL lacked a rally. SMILE FOR UR I D five wide into the first turn, tired. CURRAGH MON staged a steady retreat.
