Footnotes

COUNTRY CAUCUS away in good order, set the pace along the inside while firmly in hand, pulled away turning into the stretch, kept to task. BEAUTIFUL PRAYER stalked the two leaders while saving ground in the second flight, angled out turning for home, could do little with the winner the final furlong, well clear of the others. FUSAICHI VALENTINE also in the second ground while between foes, three wide turning for home, finished best of the rest. MYSTIC BAND a bit tight at the start, dueled up front while off the inside, weakened in the drive after racing four wide out of the final turn. ELEGANTLY QUIET in tight at the start, made little impact. TEMPTED 'N TRIED forwardly placed and four wide into the first turn, continued to race within striking distance, four wide late second turn, faded through the stretch. OLEMISS REBEL also four wide into the first turn, showed little in a dull effort. S. A. DANCER fell far back, distanced.
