Footnotes

TIZ A SCHOLAR stalked the pace for three quarters while three wide, moved to challenge late in the second turn, long drive off the inside, gained the nod at the wire. PINEVILLE set or forced the pace along the inside, garnered a slightly larger advantage between calls in the second turn, responded when challenged by the winner soon after, proved stubborn to the end. MONARCHOS BOY settled off the pace while toward the inside, continued unhurried into the far turn, steadied when boxed in exiting that bend, moved out nearing the furlong marker for room, set down, finished willingly while too late. FIEND A BIT off the pace, moved out, advanced and got closest four wide turning for home, hung in the drive. HE'S PERFECT lacked speed off the inside, angled out four wide turning for home, came up empty. BIG SPECULATOR never seriously threatened off the inside. CRYPTO JAZZ pressed the early pace, vied into the far turn, gave way in the drive. ST. PAULI BOY off a bit slow, trailed most of the way.
