WILBY'S RAY behind the leaders, challenged three wide into the stretch, drove strongly clear. HELLO LADIES lacked speed, roused in the three path out of the turn, rallied and was up in time for the place, no match for the winner. SILKY GIFT pressured the leader off the inside, moved a bit closer turn, between foes into the stretch and had little left late to be caught for the place. LEESTOWNS FINALE settled off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, did not have enough for the show. COLE'S MUSIC well off the pace and the inside, five wide and between foes into the stretch, managed little in the way of a rally. COWPUNCHER broke on top, set the pace along the inside for a half, gave way when headed by the winner upper stretch. INTERLACHEN broke to the outside, trailed, fanned six wide out of the turn, remained back.
