SOMEKINDAPUNCH outrun in the early, asked along in the three path late turn, split foes, brushed midstretch, all out to be up late. QUICK RULER took over soon after the start, got clear in the turn, garnered a larger advantage midstretch, could not last. LEESTOWN GIRL within striking distance behind the leaders, moved out, four wide into the lane, brushed with the winner nearing midstretch, could not match strides with that one late, also outkicked for the place. LITTLE LIVELY LOU lacked speed, saved ground into the lane, improved inside of several rivals, moved out a bit but was outfinished by the top three late. CURVES void of early foot, came five wide out of the turn, displayed some late interest while remaining well out in the strip. IT'S A TALE back off the pace, altered course to the far outside for the drive, finished up evenly. COMBAT'S LIL JAN chased the leader for a half, backed up through the stretch. COME AROUND GIRL was never involved. PRINCESS PAM was finished early.
