MOCHA EXPRESS dueled into the first turn toward the inside, allowed the speed to go in the run down the backstretch, went back to the fore three wide in the second turn, drew out and won ridden out in track record time. LEAVE A LEGACY, void of early foot, commenced his rally in the final bend while off the inside and finished willingly while no real threat to the winner. CHIEF THREE SOX, steadied past the wire the first time, recovered and settled off the pace, advance on the outside turning for home and finished best of the rest. ONE MEAN MAN, squeezed at the start, picked up a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. RELIC REWARD came in at the start, lacked early foot and showed little in a dull effort. PREMIER MARK set the pace until turning for home and weakened when displaced by the winner. SIR TIFF made a sudden move to challenge midway down the backstretch, gave way with a quarter remaining and continued to back up.
