FRANKLY CLASSIC lacked early foot, commenced his rally off the inside, moved smartly into the stretch and continued with good energy to be clear. SOME RUNAWAY, completely devoid of early foot, raced in traffic into the straight, took up a furlong out when in tight, steadied again soon after, recovered and finished well. SILVER ON SILVER showed the way into the first turn, continued to set the pace and gave ground grudgingly. KAZLIV settled off the pace, moved closer into the stretch, came in to set off a chain reaction of interference, was straightened and went evenly to the finish. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, KAZLIV WAS DISQUALIFIED FOR INTERFERENCE AND PLACED FIFTH. CAPTAIN COUNTDOWN, forwardly placed, steadied when moving closer up the rail late on the backstretch, took up sharply past the furlong marker when in tight again and did not recover. CRAFTY STAR was not a serious threat. I'M MAGIC TOO, five wide in the first turn, was six wide into the stretch. BRASSY WELLS prompted the pace for five furlongs and began to fade. DON'T BE LONG Z, five wide into the stretch, backed up.
