### Footnotes

STREET LIFE BLUES within striking distance, moved closer in the second turn, challenged into the straight, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, dug in late to narrowly hold on. PALM ROAD lacked early foot, was advancing when carried out five wide turning for home, lost some ground, late bid outside, missed. SMARTLIGHTANDQUIT raced back off the pace and the inside, split foes nearing the furlong marker, late traffic, finished up willingly while continuing between foes at the wire. HARD WORKING DAN broke on top, showed the way past the wire the first time, continued to set the pace up the backstretch, responded when challenged by the winner late in the second turn, drifted out inside the furlong grounds while tiring. DADDY BEN settled off the pace while racing outside, moved a bit closer while three wide late in the second turn, lacked a further bid. SWOROVSKI forwardly placed early, fell back a bit the middle half, angled out to be four wide turning for home, came up empty for the drive. SKINT BACK pressured the pace for six furlongs, faltered in the drive while racing along the inside. TAPPED TO THE MAX off a step slow, trailed early, never a factor. A. P. JOE in some traffic in the first turn, faded after a half. PER LOUISIANA RACING COMMISSION RULING #20307, STREET LIFE BLUES WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED LAST AFTER FAILING A POST RACE TEST. THE PURSE WAS REDISTRIBUTED.
