SISTER SWANK behind the first flight off the inside and unhurried, asked for some run turning for home, full of run to win going away well out in the strip. HUMBLE LANE five wide when with the pace into the turn, proved no match for the winner, narrowly held the place. HOLY ASTRA vied up front closest to the inside, missed the place. MOMMA'S GIRL vied up front four wide and between foes, pinched back early in the turn, recovered and went evenly to the wire. SUCCESSFUL CAT vied up front, gained a slight advantage late in the turn, faltered through the stretch. FINE OKIE failed to menace. SULTRY SIREN remained back. HEAVENLY CAST never dangerous. KELLI'S LAW early foot, stopped.
