MANDIMAX unhurried early after not breaking with the field, began a steady gain after a half, three wide into the lane, in time. NITECAP broke sharp, showed the way into and through the first turn, clear before a half, extended that advantage when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. HOWELL PARK went one paced throughout while within striking distance, finished best of the rest. NOBLE SMITH pressured the runner up early, closest to that rival up the backstretch and through the final turn, weakened in the drive. LATCH LIGHTING lacked a late bid. WIMBLEDON PRINCE crowded back at the start, never a threat while racing outside. DEACON BOB was finished early, well back. MANE MAN showed nothing.
