DIAMOND BLADE bumped with ROAD HAWK at the start, recovered to race toward the front while inside, altered course to the outside for room inside the furlong marker, bid, edged clear. PENNEY N A PRAYER away in good order, set the pace along the inside, continued to show the way into the, gave ground grudgingly to the winner. ONE TRUE SUN back off the pace, two path into lane, staged a mild rally while moving outside to be up for the show. MY TIGER MAN behind the leaders off the rail, continued behind horses while in hand late in the turn, late run, missed the show. RISEN IN DEED turned in an even effort while racing outside. ROAD HAWK bumped at the start, trailed for three furlongs, showed some belated interest to improve position. WAR CHIEF managed little in the way of a response in the drive. CAJUN CAVEMAN hopped at the start, four wide into the lane, also had little for the drive. KENTUCKY BOOTS closest to the runner up for three furlongs, gave way in the drive. LONESOME WHO forwardly placed for three furlongs as well, also backed up through the stretch.
