JOEY THE SCHOLAR never far back while racing off the inside, came four wide into the stretch, challenged soon after, got clear, held the runner up safe late. JOSHUA REYNOLDS last away, trailed for almost six furlongs, roused three wide late in the final turn, moved out to be widest in the drive, finished willingly to be coming late. KELLY'SPREMONITION broke out, raced off the pace, came five wide out of the second turn, finished up best of the rest. RYDER RIVER lacked speed, advanced, in a bit tight along the rail midstretch, showed some mild late interest after getting through. ONLY MAN IN TOWN prompted the leader off the inside, challenged in the second turn, weakened in the drive. SLIGO JOE brushed at the start, raced within striking distance off the inside, came up empty for the drive. WINDY LOU broke well, set the pace along the inside, faltered when headed upper straight. MAE B TODAY settled in mid pack early, failed to respond in the drive. CORREDOR CAT four wide trip, no threat. MISSIN HOME was finished after a half, trailed home.
