Footnotes

HIGH WIRE DANCER dwelt at the start, moved up to race in the second flight while between foes into the turn, four wide bid entering the stretch, drove well clear. ATRO outrun in the early going, came four wide out of the turn, rallied to be clear for the place, no threat to the winner. SUPER HALO set or forced the pace closest to the rail of the first flight, no match for the top two in the drive, saved the show. ILE BE SHREWED lacked early foot, improved position by passing mostly tiring rivals, gaining for the show. SHECKY RAY vied up front while racing three wide, gave way. THE GOLDEN STREAM closest to the early leaders, had little left for the drive. BUNKHOUSE vied up front while between rivals in the run up the backstretch, held a narrow advantage late in the turn, stopped in the drive. BAD AS GAVIN hesitated at the start, trailed throughout in showing little.
