ZARA LAUREN pressured the early leader off the inside, moved up to duel before a half, continued to alternate for the lead second turn, shook clear, kept to task. IVY MOUNTAIN pulled while behind the leader, continued under restraint while in the second flight late in the final turn, set down when clear for the drive, rallied for the place, no real threat to the winner. CRASH CODE moved up to show the way early, alternated with the winner the middle half along the inside, came out, brushed late with TUNICA GIRL, gained the nod for the show over that same foe. TUNICA GIRL firmly rated off the pace, moved a bit closer in some traffic second turn, lacked clear room upper stretch, continued in tight quarters, brushed with CRASH CODE late, missed the show. DEVIL IS BAD prompted the pace off the inside, had little left for the drive. KAT'S CADY JO settled in mid pack early, lacked a rally. MOLLY B off a bit slow, trailed most of the way. CRAZY DARREL always outrun.
