CHAWNADO moved up to vie for the lead toward the inside, dueled turn, disposed of the other speed nearing the furlong marker to be clear, enough left to hold the runner up off late. GRAN PUNCH off a bit slow, moved up to a position behind the leaders, angled out slightly for room bumping with BAYOU DE STORM in midstretch, straightened, finished willingly while unable to get to the winner in the final strides. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE BUMPING INCIDENT IN MIDSTRETCH, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. BAYOU DE STORM off the early pace, raced four wide when moving toward the front in the turn, exchanged bumps with the runner up a furlong out while outside that foe, closed on the winner late but did not have enough to seriously contend in the final strides. JULIE'S RED BANDIT settled in the second flight, lacked a kick in the drive. MR. PORTER broke sharp, cleared toward the inside but allowed the winner the rail, dueled with that one and gave way the final furlong. LAA WINDY void of early foot, trailed for three furlongs, passed tiring foes. HONEY HUSH lacked speed while between foes, failed to rally. ZARBYEV NIGHT BOY steadied at the start, raced four wide into the turn, failed to menace. GRITTY WALKING remained back throughout. HIGH ZARB steadily faded off the inside.
