WARREN'S DOVE broke on top, cleared toward but not to the inside, set the pace, vied between foes through the second turn, drew clear in the drive under steady handling, drifted late. TIZ A SCHOLAR lacked speed, saved ground, asked along into the stretch while continuing inside, moved out a bit and finished up willingly to be in time for the place, no match for the winner. PRIETO JOLIE last away, trailed, came five wide out of the final turn, staged a rally and was up for the show outside. LATCH LIGHTING forwardly placed and along the inside, steadied when in tight between the winner and the rail late first turn, moved back up inside, vied through the second turn along the rail, weakened in the drive. COUPLE OF HOURS evenly paced, moved a bit closer four wide turning for home, failed to muster any additional gain through the stretch. TIME LIMIT behind the first flight toward the inside, had little for the drive. KNOCK made little impact. LUCKY RAJA fractious in the gate, raced forwardly, vied three wide into and through the final turn, gave way.
