SEE THE STREAK within striking distance outside, fell back off the leader into the turn, set down, rallied, pushed out late, gained the nod while widest of first flight at the wire. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE FIRST FLIGHT AT THE WIRE, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. EXCLUSIVE ALLIANCE forwardly placed toward the inside, also fell back second turn, moved out, late bid between foes, also pushed out by the tiring leader in turning pushing the winner out, missed. LARRY'S VISION got clear soon after the start to set the pace, relaxed the middle half mile. gained a larger lead into the lane, weakened while drifting out in the late going, nipped at the wire. REGIONS REWARD chased the leader much of the way off the inside, weakened. WASH PARK settled off the pace, in some traffic into the stretch, failed to menace in the drive. LANDON PAUL lacked speed, came five wide out of the final turn, managed little in the way of a rally. NOLAN'S REVENGE four wide in the first turn, continued outside and tired. WHO'S STEVE last away, trailed throughout.
