Footnotes

BONNIES JUDGE rated close up behind the pace while off the inside, three wide into the lane, roused, challenged soon after, drove clear. IM YOUR DEVIL dueled up front off the inside, continued to vied while between foes midstretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late, gained the nod for the place. FOXY KITTEN alternated up front while closest to the inside, continued to contest the issue, allowed a foe the rail late, lost the nod for the place while between foes. BEFORE HER TIME off the pace and the inside, came four wide into the straight, not enough for the place while well out in the course at the wire. ALYS TWO WAY WORLD last away, saved ground, got through along the inside late, also did not have enough for the place in the final strides. STACEY LEE off the pace, raced four out to five wide through the second turn, failed to respond when asked for the drive. BARD'S DAY forwardly placed for six furlongs outside, tired while four wide.
