SENSE OF HOME forwardly placed, checked up in tight quarters into the turn, recovered and moved to the outside, long drive, could not get to the winner late. DO THE TIGER pressured the winner throughout from along the inside, also did not have enough in the late going while continuing along the rail. CLASSY IDE closest to the winner in the early going, weakened in the drive. IDE DON'T CARE WHO last away, continued to lack early foot, trailed home.
