DUSTIN DUDE behind the first flight in the two path, continued to track the leaders out of the turn, moved out when straightened for home, set down, bid, proved best under firm handling. POSSE COMITATUS lacked speed, asked along while still well back late in the turn, fanned six wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the middle of the strip, game for the place. HELICOPTER ACE broke in slightly, lacked speed, angled out, traffic, three wide late turn, also closed some ground out in the strip, missed the place. THE DEMON CHILD with the pace outside, contested the issue four wide through the turn, showed the way past the furlong marker, larger lead, could not contain the winner, caught late for the place. FINE TROUBLEMAKER broke sharp, showed the way early, vied closest to the inside through the turn and into the stretch, faltered. ON THE RADAR pressed, vied three wide and between foes through the turn, gave way in the drive. CLUB off the pace, in a bit tight late in the turn, continued between foes upper stretch, steered to the inside and improved a

bit. LAKE POMEROY with the pace while between foes, backed up in the drive. GLITTER OF HONOUR off the pace, fanned five wide out of the turn, lacked a rally. WILLIE ARTHUR void of speed, was never close. HEZA CHAMP steadied at the start, raced back and wide. SWINGIN CAT steadily faded.
