CORNICELLI allowed the pace to go, closest to the two leaders into the far turn, advanced, challenged into the lane, duelled past the furlong marker, clear late. BETH'S CROSSING pressed early, moved up to duel off the inside after a half, disposed of the other speed late in the final turn, responded when confronted by the winner soon after, equal terms past the furlong marker, gave ground grudgingly. IDEAL ZARB well off the early pace, made a good advance along the inside second turn, traffic, waited with a quarter to run, moved out, staged a mild rally to annex the show while not a threat to the top two. GULUK BOY settled off the pace, raced four wide through the second turn, closer nearing the furlong grounds, flattened out and was caught for the show. MR BARRETTE RUN void of speed, swung out to be four wide exiting the final turn, improved position without posing a serious threat. I'M GOOD TO GO last away, trailed for six furlongs, passed tiring foes after the issue had been decided. S P WARRIOR lacked speed, saved some ground into the stretch, put in tight with a furlong remaining, lacked a kick when clear. HEY PODZ showed the way for a half, duelled into the far turn, gave way with a quarter remaining. STRONG FINISH in the second group, gave way while three wide late in the final bend.
