MASS MEDIA with the early pace, shook clear, drew off down the lane to win ridden out in a sharp effort. TRUST ME settled early, made a bold move four wide in the turn to reach contention, no match for the winner. SUMMERTIME MOOD back off the early pace, roused four wide turning for home, finished best of the rest. BC'S MUSIC pressured the pace for a half while off the inside, weakened. ANTE UP PETE off slowly, rushed up, came five wide into the stretch, improved position. TRIFECTA early foot inside, fell back while continuing along the rail, went evenly through the stretch. SHOT GUN TERRY off slow, picked off a couple of tiring rivals. ROSE COUNTRY MAN slow leaving, remained back. A TEAM LEADER tired outside. LAY IT ON ME (GB) forward, stopped late in the turn. SENOR GRAN DAY off bit slow, well beaten.
