LIGHTLIGHTLIGHT unhurried early while racing toward the inside, continued to save ground under patient handling, began to advance second turn, got through under clever handling turning for home, bid soon after and proved best. TENSAS PALMYRA forwardly placed, lodged an early bid along the rail into the far turn, showed the way into the stretch, responded when challenged by the winner, drifted out to bother outer foes then came in to impede MUFFIN soon after, outfinished. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, TENSAS PALMYRA was disqualified and placed fifth. CAJUN CONFERENCE pressured the early leader, joined that one to vie into and through the second turn, continued to be prominent in midstretch when TENSAS PALMYRA drifted out, bothered, finished up evenly. SEVEN SEVENTYTHREE void of early speed, moved out to be five wide turning for home, slight bother midstretch, some late gain while continuing well out in the strip. MUFFIN lacked speed, raced in some traffic when advancing into the lane, continued to gain, impeded in the late going when TENSAS PALMYRA came in. DUBAI STAR evenly paced off the pace, moved closer four wide turning for home, bothered as a result of a chain reaction of interference set off when TENSAS PALMYRA drifted out in midstretch, recovered but was in traffic late. SUNDAY IN THE BAY void of early foot, improved position only slightly in the drive. SKIPPING TOWN set the pace, gave way in the far turn. SISSY BABY began to fade after a half.
