Non winners of a Sweepstakes allowed 3 lbs.; One race other than maiden or claiming allowed 5 lbs.; Maidens allowed 7 lbs. By subscription of \$100 each on or before July 18. \$375 to pass the entry box and an additional \$375 to start with \$75,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest earnings in 2009. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. ### Footnotes

KING OF THE BAYOU lacked speed, waited briefly in traffic late in the turn, moved out a bit for room and finished full of turn to be clear late. HEAVENVILLE behind the first flight, raced inside, could not match strides with the winner late, up for the place. ROYAL PRODUCTION vied up front through a quick opening quarter, shook clear after a half, could not withstand the winner, caught late for the place. BECCA'S BEAU helped set that quick opening quarter, fell back turning for home and continued to weaken. DERICKHAND void of early foot, staged a belated rally while never dangerous. TOO FROSTY behind the first flight, came up empty for the drive. WHOLELOTAKING failed to get involved. WOODROW CALL tired while five wide turning for home. THE BOSSER chased early, stopped in the drive.
