LOUISIANA FLYBOY off step slow then roughed between rivals, trailed, began a steady advance after a quarter, swung out six wide turning for home, set down and finished full of run to win going away down the center of the strip. YES IT'S A FACT narrowly set the pace, clear past the furlong marker, no match for the winner, held the place. YOUVE GOT A FRIEND settled off the early pace, moved out, asked along three wide late turn, slowly getting to the runner up late while also not a threat to the winner. SUNKEN ROAD pressured the pace off the inside, chased into the stretch, little left in the late going. DON'T RUSH ME raced off the early pace toward the inside, steered out for room entering the stretch, came up empty when asked. BULLDOZER BRENT back off the pace and the inside, four out to five wide late in the turn, also failed to respond when called on upper stretch. FAB TRIPS off a bit slow, raced back, fanned seven wide by the winner exiting the turn, improved a bit by passing tiring rivals. RANDY PAUL broke sharply to the inside bumping both the winner and DERAILER, was not a threat in remaining back. ROOKIE DOO had nothing for the drive while racing inside. DERAILER bumped at the start, quickly recovered to pressure the pace, was giving way when four wide late in the turn, drifted in when straightened for home, continued to weaken. TURBO was finished early, showed little.
