CANNY broke sharp, was with the leaders out of the chute allowed the pace to go, moved out and stalked into the turn, outside bid into the stretch, clearly best. GRINDERS WAY off the pace for a half, roused for the drive, finished willingly for the place while not a danger to the winner. ZARBA THE GEEK set or forced the pace while off the pace rail for a half and weakened. S P WARRIOR remained back in failing to threaten. DOUBLE FUDGE SWERL with the pace for a half, gave way in the drive.
