**Footnotes**

KEY LEE vied up front from the start while off the inside, continued to do battle in the stretch, prevailed in determined fashion. ANOTHER HUGGER vied up front while off the inside, could not match strides with the winner late, gained the nod for the place. BANDIT'S B HAVEN never far back, set down for the drive, moved out, finished willingly to miss the place. WHERE'S JOE lacked speed while saving some ground in the turn, angled out and split foes in the four path nearing the furlong grounds, improved position a bit with some modest late interest. JETABUG off the pace, moved out to the middle of the strip for the drive, never dangerous. VALID ROMANCE with the early pace, fell back a bit when in tight and forced to steady slightly into the turn, went evenly in the drive. ARCTIC INDIAN in a bit tight at the start, got out late in the turn when mounting a mild advanced, improved a bit in the stretch while never a threat. PRINCESS NOTGONNA last away, void of early foot, also improved improved slightly. ERL GIRL stalked off the inside, had nothing for the drive. BEFORE HER TIME raced back, carried wide late turn, no rally stretch. BETHSGONEWEST forwardly placed for three furlongs, gave way in the drive. BELLA AMORE trailed from the start, eased.
