CAJUN MAID forwardly placed outside, moved closer under confident handling late in the turn, challenged entering the stretch, drove clear, drifted in a bit, kept to task. LIVELY STONE vied up front while racing off the inside, briefly raced on equal terms with the winner nearing the furlong marker, proved no match for that one late, held sway for the place. TERRE NOIRE showed the way early while toward but not on the inside, continued to vie in the two path into the stretch, weakened, outkicked for the place, comfortably clear of the rest. KAKI'S STORM bobbled slightly at the start, failed to menace. DARBY SAYS SEE YA void of speed, made little impact while racing well out in the strip. CRYPTO GOOD off the early pace, moved a bit closer in the turn while on the rail, gave way in the drive. CAJUN COWGIRL briefly forwardly placed, was finished before a half, trailed well back.
