STORMY SURGE unhurried early, angled out a bit for room upper straight, set down for the drive, finished up willingly to be clear. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE STRETCH RUN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. ROCK 'N RAIL last away, trailed, began to rally out of final turn, forced to steady when a hole of was taken away by the winner, recovered and was going well at the end. STOPKA settled well off the pace, came five wide into the lane, outkicked for the place. NOTHINBUTTROUBLE set or forced the pace until less than a furlong remained and weakened. MR. PORTER also a pace factor most of the way, faltered the final furlong. TACO TODDY tired from early efforts. MASTER EWING MALOY was finished before six furlongs.
