K P PRINCESS closest to the two leaders after breaking in good order, continued to stalk that pair up the backstretch, ranged up three wide to challenge midway on the second turn, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker and held sway in the late going. ABOVE THE LAW pulled early while off the pace, moved closer while still under restraint far turn, boxed in with a quarter to run toward rail, shifted out for the drive, split foes and finished up well to earn the place. ATAKA'S SPECIAL four wide into the first turn, again in the far turn when advancing, five wide into the straight, improved but was outkicked for the place. FOURTEENGUNSALUTE duelled up front off the inside, proved stubborn until the late going. FANCY THAT void of speed, came five wide out of the final turn, managed only a modest late rally. ASPEN TRIAL lacked a response when asked in the drive. RAMSAY remained back while also coming up empty for the stretch run. DANCIN N PRANCIN tired from early efforts. HAGGITH duelled up front closest to the inside, backed up in the drive.
