WAR BONNET outrun in the early going, came five wide out of the turn when still well back off the leaders, set down for the drive, closed with good late energy to win going away midtrack. LOUISIANA ANGEL close up on the outside, took over midway on the turn, got out turning for home, showed the way past the furlong marker but was unable to contain the winner late. PRINCESS MIA forwardly placed toward the inside for three furlongs, two path into the lane, lodged a brief bid between rivals past the furlong marker, flattened out a bit and was outkicked for the place spot. I KNOW JOE lacked early foot, moved closer while well out in the strip nearing the furlong marker, also failed to sustain that energy in the late going. ADDISON'S HOPE steadied at the start, raced well back, traffic upper stretch, moved out, improved position. SIX SECTION narrowly showed the way early, dueed turn, gave way in the drive. JAMIN BABY four wide out of the turn, failed to rally. SMOKEY RITZ flashed some brief speed inside, staged a steady retreat.
