MAVERICK PRINCE broke out, quickly straightened to race forwardly into the first turn, moved up to vie three wide onto the backstretch, garnered a larger lead in the second turn while still in hand, expanded advantage upper stretch, maintained daylight to the wire while being kept to task. HOWELL PARK vied up front early while between foes, fell back off the winner far turn, chased past the furlong marker, trimmed lead late, clearly 2nd best. TWO CROWNS lacked early foot, advanced three wide, dropped inside for the drive, finished up best of the rest. LOUISIANA BANDIT void of speed for six furlongs, improved position stretch, never dangerous. ZARB'S WHIRL fell back to trail, passed tiring foes while also never a serious threat. RIVER RIDGE vied up front early closest to the inside, gave way after five furlongs. LEEISIANA BLUES back off the pace, loomed closer on the outside in the second turn, faltered. BUCK'S BILL raced within striking distance early outside, was tiring down the lane when bothered, continued to back up.
