CALHOUN STONEWALL outrun in the early going, began to advance while four wide through the turn, collared the leader with a sixteenth to run, edged clear under steady handling. SHERIFF WARREN stalked the early leaders in the second group outside, moved to challenge late in the turn, took over into the lane, briefly clear, could not match the winner the final sixteenth. ORLEANIAN lacked speed, staged a mild rally three wide to finish clear of the others, no match top two. SILKYS LAST DEAL dueled up front early, disposed of the other early speed midway on the turn to be clear, challenged by the winner soon after and began to weaken. CREEDS FORD lacked speed, came five wide into the lane, made little impact. GONE FOR HOME in the second group inside the runner up, had little for the drive. MARGOS SOUTHERNBOY was finished early. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L dueled early along the inside, stopped.
