FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. (Includes \$50,000 from Slot Revenue). No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start. \$50,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Weights: Colts and Geldings 121 lbs. Fillies 118 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. The Sunny's Halo will be limited to eleven (11) starters. Preference to horses with the highest earnings. Different owners will have equal draw according to earnings. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, July 21, 2012 with 22 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

Footnotes

BROWN ALMIGHTY moved inside soon after the start, prompted the pace first turn, moved up inside to challenge before a half, vied through the second turn closest to the inside, put the other speed away past the furlong marker and drove clear. MR. BANDINI'S BAND never far back off the inside, vied between rivals into and through the second turn, continued on equal terms with the winner approaching the furlong grounds, could not match strides with that same foe to the wire, remained clear for the place. UNBRIDLED'S SCORE within striking distance early, continued behind the leaders in the two path the middle half, moved out a bit for the drive but could do little with the top pair the final furlong. THEMISTOCLES void of speed, advanced along the inside late in the second turn and into the lane, continued with some modest interest to the wire while not a posing a serious threat. LORE'S DYNAMEAUX brushed at the start, raced back, managed some modest improvement while also not a serious threat for the win. CONCHO HALO void of speed, passed tiring foes. ASK CHARLIE broke in, settled, faded while four wide into the stretch. CHANGING KARMA broke in, bothered at the start, off the early pace, moved up to vie three wide into the far turn, retreated down the lane. SEQUOYAH WELLS got out past the wire the first time, dueled first turn well out in the course, continued wide, stopped into the far turn. FAIRY MISSILE ducked out start, dueled early outside, also stopped while racing wide.
