MINEISCOOKIN' asked a bit early to maintain inside position, showed the way late backstretch, dueled through the turn, shook off the other speed past the furlong marker, clear, driving. HAY DUDE broke alertly, showed the way early, headed into the turn, dueled the middle quarter, could not match the winner the late, held the place. SALTY RIDGE off the pace and the inside, roused in the two path turning for home, finished up best of the rest. COLTON COUNTDOWN off slowly, trailed, four wide into the stretch, found best stride too late down the middle of the strip. TALE OF A GOLFER well back off the pace and the inside, four wide through the turn, failed to rally. TRICKY RED DEVIL within striking distance while three wide, came up empty in the drive. MORE OR LEX lacked speed, also failed to muster a response in the drive. POWDERHORN HEAT was outrun while wide. JUST EXPECTATIONS steadily faded.
