DUSTY TUNNEL stalked the pace three wide, challenged turning for home, wore down the leader under firm handling. CITIZEN'S REQUEST set the pace while well in hand, proved no match for the winner the final furlong, remained clear for the place. GOIN SAVIN lacked early foot, traffic late in the second turn, saved ground into the lane, improved position, just up for the place. K. J.'S GOLD settled off the pace while saving ground, steadied in lacking room far turn, came up empty for the drive when clear. LISTEN INDY last away, trailed, five wide into the lane, little rally. BLUE SPADE prompted the pace for five furlongs and faltered. SITE ALARM showed little in a dull effort.
