Footnotes

FATTY LANGBEIN broke in, bothered RHYTHMIC SONG, raced back off the pace, steady advance four wide through the turn, challenged entering the stretch, proved best under steady handling. SOLITARY THINKIN pressured the early leader, moved up to engage that rival in the turn, vied between foes into the stretch, came in slightly to tighten up a tiring DOWNTOWN CHARLIE in upper stretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner and was clearly second best. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF DOWNTOWN CHARLIE AGAINST SOLITARY THINKIN FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. DOWNTOWN CHARLIE broke alertly, showed the way early along the inside, was tiring a bit when in tight nearing the furlong grounds, no match for the top two late, held the show. GOLD ROAD MINE off the pace outside, in some traffic, floated out five wide turning for home, went evenly to the wire in lacking a significant late kick. NORMAN G within striking distance early, moved a bit closer three wide late in the turn, weakened in the drive. MIDTOWN GROOM lacked speed, got out a bit to be four wide late in the turn, tired in the drive. RHYTHMIC SONG bothered at the start, sluggish, trailed throughout in a dull effort.
