Footnotes

BENDANIE got clear and to the inside past the wire the first time, long lead while rating early backstretch, briefly headed into the far turn, regained the advantage, stayed clear late. PERFECT JADE settled inside off the pace while under restraint, moved a bit closer in some traffic into the far turn, moved out, three wide into the lane, could do little with the winner late, up for place. AMMANN RD in the second flight off the inside, challenged three wide entering the final turn, fell back steadily through that bend, moved to the far outside for the drive, coming again late while far out in the course, missed place. QUIET TITLE void of early foot, saved some ground into the stretch, displayed a modest amount of late interest. ROMAN FOREST chased the winner, went after that rival and put a head in front three furlongs out, lost the advantage soon after, remained closest to the victor past the furlong marker, faltered late. MACEDONIAN lacked speed, in some traffic in the two path into the stretch, bothered slightly, lacked a late kick. FESTIVE DANCER in the second group, moved closer four wide through the second turn, faded. DOIN BIG BIDNESS unruly in the gate, trailed throughout.
