R U'S GOLDEN LADY outrun in the early going while off the inside, swung out to be five wide out of the turn, finished full of run down the middle of the strip to win going away. TRIME broke sharply, raced forwardly and outside, lodged a brief bid three wide and inside the winner just inside the furlong grounds, no match for that foe, determined for the place. LOVER IN A STORM took control soon after the start, continued to show the way through and out of the turn, also was no match for the winner, outfinished for the place spot. ROYAL TIKA pressured the leader from the outside, challenged and dueled through the turn, weakened final furlong. ESPECIALY SPECIAL void of early foot in trailing, improved position while not a serious threat. WHY GO WEST had little for the drive. CARSON'S BREW also lacked a late bid. ERMOSA PRINSESA through early, trailed home.
