**Footnotes**

HOPE'S VICTORY lacked speed toward the inside, moved a bit closer in the second turn, angled out for room to be four wide into the lane under clever handling, set down, finished up full of run on the outside to be in time. GOODSPOT prompted the pace off the inside, took over past the furlong marker, caught in the late going. SEVERE FLYING settled in mid pack, raced in some traffic midway on the second turn and into the stretch, staged a mild rally while continuing between foes to be in time for the show. RED SPIRIT away in good order, showed the way early, continued to set the pace the middle half, weakened when headed past the furlong marker. NATIVE DAZZLER four wide into the first turn, continued outside and within striking distance up the backstretch, moved a bit closer while three wide late in the final turn, lacked a further bid in the drive. MINI WINZ back early off the pace, advanced with a modest middle move while four wide in the second turn, hung. DOUBLE DOWN DELTA forwardly placed along the inside, boxed in along the rail turning for home, taken back to lose position, roused, remained back. E DUBAI PAGEANT off a bit slow, behind traffic into the straight, failed to rally when clear. JAMI ROAD broke a bit in the air and awkwardly, unseated rider.
