Footnotes

MY SILVER LULLABY outrun for six furlongs, swung out six wide into the lane when beginning to rally, finished with good late energy to be in time. TANGERINE DREAM broke out but alertly, raced closest to the two leaders backstretch, challenged between foes with a sixteenth to run, could not match the winner late, held sway for the place. HOODATCROOK bothered at the start, raced well back off the pace, five out to six wide late in the second turn, lost some ground to the runner up into the straight, could not get back to that rival for the place while also no match for the winner in the final strides. TEARS IN MY EYES void of any speed for six furlongs, steered to the far outside when straightened for home, finished willingly while too late. STORM TRIP used early to clear from the outside, showed the way through the first turn, dueled up the backstretch and through the final turn, clear again briefly with a furlong remaining, faltered. TRUELLADEVILLE settled off the pace and the inside, in some traffic late in the final turn and into the lane, improved slightly while finishing up evenly. LEESTOWN GIRL raced off the pace and the inside, two path into the lane, lacked a significant late kick. PEN CITY forwardly placed, moved up to duel off the inside onto the backstretch, gave way in the drive. TIDAL PLAIN within striking distance behind the two leaders in the two path, came up empty when asked in the drive. GOLDONNA off a bit slow, far back, five wide into the lane, no rally. CHARGRAY saved ground while behind the pace, waited briefly along the rail turning for home, faded in the drive while continuing inside. STARFISH bothered slightly at the start, raced in some early

traffic, moved closer while four wide late in the final turn, gave way in the drive.
