DRINK AND A WINK pressured the leader through some soft splits while in hand, bid, took over turning for home, clear, lasted. ABBIES MY DADDY lacked speed while off the inside, came four wide when beginning to rally into the stretch, finished willingly to be getting to the winner late. SINGLE LADY settled off the pace, also came four wide exiting the turn, along for the show. KELATEQUILA settled off the pace and the inside, moved closer while three wide late in the final turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. COUNT FLEET BEAT last to leave, void of speed, behind some traffic late in the final turn, improved when clear in the drive. STICKER clear early, set a soft pace under restraint, weakened when headed by the winner turning for home. BETTER N NUTTIN forwardly placed early, had little for the drive. ARAUCARIA tired from early efforts. LITTLE MINNIE was finished after a half, four wide into lane. APRIL MAY FLY trailed throughout in a dull effort.
