STAKES Sunny's Halo S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. (Includes \$50,000 from Slot Revenue). No nomination fee. \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start. \$50,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Weights: Colts and Geldings 121 lbs. Fillies 118 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs.; a race other than claiming, 6 lbs. The Sunny' Halo will be limited to eleven (11) starters. Preference to horses with the highest earnings. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, July 23, 2011 with 74 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

### Footnotes

TEQUILA FACTOR saved ground behind the leaders, continued inside under some clever handling through the second turn, moved out for the drive, set down, strong bid with a sixteenth remaining, held late. EASTON JACK off a step slow, raced back off the pace, advanced inside, finished up willingly to be closing the gap a bit on the winner late. QUIET ACCELERATION settled in the second flight three wide, continued stalk in the run up the backstretch, a bit closer second turn, lacked a further bid, gained the nod for the show. WORTHINGTON broke well, dueled up front while in hand and closest to the inside, shook off the other speed when straightened for home, weakened in the going, lost the nod for the show. DOUBLE BIRDIE pushed out to be five wide into the first turn, continued outside in the second group, four wide through the second turn, failed to muster a rally. NOBLE ALEX steadied in some traffic early in the first turn, came five wide out of the second turn, also lacked a late kick. SWORD TRICK dueled up front off the inside and under restraint, continued to alternate up front into and through the second turn, gave way in the drive. OUR FINAL CHANCE was finished after a half. MASCULINO rank, checked up early, trailed.
