Footnotes

TRUBS patiently handled behind the early pace toward the inside, moved out second turn, dropped back to the inside for the drive, challenged up the rail and proved best in game fashion. POPULIST POLITICS parked five wide into and through the early part of the first turn, dropped inside, well back off the pace in the run up the backstretch, moved out and launched a strong move five wide late in the second bend, gained the advantage, outfinished by the winner while outside that foe at the wire. GET IN DA HOUSE within striking distance, settled, angled out, challenged four wide and inside the runner up late in the final turn, vied briefly between the top two upper stretch, could not match strides with that pair, well clear of the others. G. W.'S D'ORO off a step slow, raced back while saving some ground, moved out late in the final turn, improved position while not a serious threat. WILS REWARD devoid of early foot, remained well back second turn, moved out widest for the drive, passed mostly tiring foes while also never dangerous. SOARING NATIVE off the pace toward the inside for six furlongs, roused into the lane, came up empty. EDDIE'S BAND broke a bit slow, moved up to race four wide when forwardly placed in the first turn, pressured the leader in the run up the backstretch, took over midway on the final turn, gave way readily in the drive. AMANECER DE ORO steadied in traffic into the first turn, settled, lacked rally. DESTINARE cleared to the inside soon after the start, set the pace, gave way when headed second turn. STRING KING raced mid pack, four wide late in the final turn, tired. STRATEGIC GAME was finished after a half.
