Footnotes

SILVER NICKEL behind the pace, waited briefly while continuing behind horses late turn, split foes, roused three wide upper stretch, edged clear. I'MABADBOY lacked speed, came in slightly into the turn to tighten FANTASTICAL up, moved out for room to be five wide turning for home, outside bid, second best. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENT ENTERING THE TURN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. TIS' TIMELESS forwardly placed, in some traffic while late in the turn, clear for the drive, finished up best of the rest. EVIL OFFICER contested the early pace, continued to vie while three wide and between rivals through the turn, weakened in the drive. PIERRE PICO broke slowly, trailed well back, came 5w into the lane, showed some belated interest while remaining well out in the strip. KRISTYS CACTUS BOY forced the early pace on the outside, continued with the first flight while four wide through the turn, gave way in the drive. TALE OF A GOLFER made little impact. RUSHMORE narrowly set the pace for a half and faltered. HELLO BUD never a threat. FANTASTICAL outrun early toward the inside, checked up in tight quarters into the turn, faded.
