SERVICE HAWK outrun in the early going, swept to the front four wide in the second turn, gained the advantage, long drive, proved best under firm handling. TWO JAYS SECRET off the early pace, briefly boxed in toward the inside late in the final turn, got through, hung around in stubborn fashion just behind and inside the winner the length of the stretch. CAPTAIN ABOVE never far back, was asked for some run in three path and just inside the winner in the second turn, proved no match for the top two in the drive. PRIVATE WIND lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, managed little in the way of a rally. CLAUDIA'S FORUM vied up front in the early going inside, weakened. KATIE'S KANDLES trailed most of the way, passed tiring foes. PRIVATE PRESLEY narrowly set the pace for almost six furlongs, stopped in the drive. MR. BRAZIL was finished early.
